**MOTION REQUESTING DIRECTION OF THE COURT AS TO VICTIM
NOTIFICATION**

Christopher L. Temple, (hereinafter "Temple") appearing Pro Se, representing and speaking for himself at all times as is his right protected under the Sixth Amendment to the Constitution, by this Motion respectfully requests the direction of the Court as to how the victims in this case, to whom restitution is owed, are to be notified of these proceedings; in part, so that they will be afforded both time and opportunity to make their views and wishes known to the Court.

The government's charge against Temple -- and certainly any sentencing/sanction proceedings that may become involved -- implicate and are affected by the provisions of his earlier sentence, plea agreement, 18 U.S.C. Sec. 3553(a)(7), the Mandatory Victims Restitution Act and other applicable laws.

As the Court already knows from his Motion and Answer filed by mail on December 13, 2010 -- and as the Probation Department knows and has been informed on

a number of previous occasions -- Temple has occasionally been contacted *by his victims*. Appropriately, this has never been deemed a violation of directives to him that *he not contact them*.

Nevertheless, Temple must question how his victims are to be informed of the competing actions now before this Court so that they will have *their* rights under the law protected. He will not do so himself without the Court's direction, so as not to run afoul of the directions previously given him, although he arguably has some right to solicit their intervention as it may affect his sentence. Thus, he needs the intervention/direction of the Court as to how she wishes these victims to be notified so that they may take action and/or make their voices heard as they deem most appropriate.
